## **HANDY HINTS**

### **CHARTERS TOWERS SHOW INDEMNITY FORM**

All Competitors and their assistants are required to read and sign the indemnity form.

### **HORSE HEALTH DECLARATION FORM**

These forms are to be filled out and handed in only on your arrival to our show; please do not send this form in with your nominations, stabling, camping etc. These forms are to ensure us that your horse, to the best of your knowledge, is fit and well and showing no signs of sickness, therefore you must hand them in on your arrival. Forms are also available at the office. Thank you for your understanding, as this is a mandatory requirement at all horse events.

**ANY HORSE DEEMED TO BE UNHEALTHY FOR COMPETITION BY JUDGES AND OR COMMITTEE MEMBERS WILL BE DISQUALIFIED AND EXCLUDED FROM ALL EVENTS.**

### **CAMPING FEE**

Please use the Charters Towers Show Webpage for all camping requirements. Camping Fees are \$35 for the duration of the show or \$12 per night if less than 3 nights. Camping permits will not be allocated without the reservations being made prior to arrival. Permits must be prominently displayed on the camp.

### **STABLING**

Please use the Charters Towers Webpage for all stable requirements. Stables are \$10 per stable and all stables will be locked upon arrival and access will be granted via the stabling marshall once bookings and fees have been confirmed. There are no double stables available.

Please note that a \$15 deposit per stall will be required upon booking and will be refunded upon after completion of the show when stalls are deemed clean by the stabling marshall. These funds will be returned direct into your nominated bank account.

## **STALLION STABLING FEE**

Standard/Stallion Stalls \$10 ea. A \$15 deposit per stall will be required upon booking and will be refunded upon departure when stalls are deemed clean. Contact Office for inspection. **All Stallions will be stabled in designated Stallion Stalls as determined by the Committee – NO EXCEPTIONS.**

## **ENTRY TICKETS**

Entry to classes can ONLY be purchased on the days of competition from the ring steward in centre ring. Entry tickets must be purchased prior to competition and when the respective class is called, the entry ticket is given to the Ring Steward. The Committee reserves the right to amend, cancel, or refuse entry without giving the reason for doing so.

**PLEASE NOTE THAT ENTRY TICKETS ARE NON-REFUNDABLE, BUT MAY BE USED THE FOLLOWING YEAR**

**COMPETITORS PLEASE BE READY** for all classes, according to the program and at times advised by the stewards. **Parents, Coaches, Grooms and/or others, may not enter the ring unless accompanying children under the age of 6 years in rider classes. One leader only. This will be strictly enforced. Please co-operate and do not attempt to enter the ring.**

**No Ticket – No Entry – No Excuses.**

## **ENTRY WRISTBANDS**

Competitors entering on the day of the show will be allocated with wristband passes which will be available at the Secretary's Office upon payment of all fees. Gates will be open from 6.30am. Competitors entry passes will be issued as follows:

1 rider – 1 pass

Riders under 18 will be allocated 1 extra pass for Parent/Guardian.

Any other drivers or passengers in the vehicle will be required to pay entry fees or produce Membership/Pre-purchased passes to gate security at the time of entry.

**NO ARMBAND – NO ENTRY – NO EXCUSES**

## **PRIZE MONEY**

Prize Money will be given out on completion of the Event by the ring steward on production of an entry card signed by the Judge or the judge's assistant. Prize Money is as stated. Anyone wishing to have a third party collect prize money must advise the ring steward in writing beforehand.

## **GENERAL REGULATIONS AND ACCEPTANCE OF RULES**

**THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS WILL BE ENFORCED, AND COMPETITORS ARE ASKED TO CO-OPERATE AND TO AVOID ANY DELAY TO THE RING PROGRAM.**

Competitors are to abide by the Chief Ring Steward, Ringmaster, Marshalling & Equestrian Stewards' directions at all times as well as the Laws of the Queensland Agricultural Society and the TPA&M Ass Inc. and to any special conditions imposed by the TPA&M Ass Inc.

The Association, Steward, Servant, Agent or Volunteer of the Association **WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE** for any accident caused through or by any exhibit or its handler. It shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the TPA&M Ass Inc. and any steward, agent, servant or volunteer of the Association blameless and indemnified against legal proceedings. The Association will not hold itself responsible for any loss, damage to or wrong delivery of any exhibit.

All exhibitors should be aware that the show includes a variety of entertainment and events, such as fireworks, motor bike exhibitions, etc. which may cause a disturbance to your animals. The exhibitor is reminded that they are responsible for taking the necessary steps to ensure the safety of their animals throughout the duration of the show.

Exhibitors are also reminded that they will be liable for any damage caused by their animals to property or person throughout the duration of their stay on the grounds. All exhibits, on the day of entry, must be the bona fide property of the Exhibitor (except in family groups) who may be required to sign a Declaration to that effect.

PLEASE NOTE: HORSES/PONIES may not be tied to any part of the grounds, fences or yards (neither inside nor outside the ring) except in those yards that have been made available for that purpose.

**The organisers reserve the right to make any necessary decisions, inclusions, or changes to this Schedule, including Conditions of Entry and Special Regulations, without further notice.**

### **SUITABLE ATTIRE & HELMETS**

IN ALL RIDING CLASSES & JUMPING EVENTS: Dress Rules as per the E.A. and any Rules stipulated by the Show Committee will apply. Suitable footwear AND APPROVED SAFETY HEADGEAR will be required at all times including when attending to the practice jump.

Any PERSONS acting as holders for LED Classes will not be permitted to enter the ring unless they have signed an indemnity form from the Secretary's Office. Any person wishing to wear a top hat must sign an indemnity form. Riders in Stock and Ranch Classes may wear western hats however must sign an indemnity form.

All riders are required to be neatly and appropriately attired whilst in the assembly yard or the judging rings in the main arena. **SHORTS, SINGLETs, THONGS AND SIMILAR ATTIRE ARE NOT PERMITTED.** Hats or English dress caps (tweed caps) may be worn by all male and female handlers in the judging rings. Ball Caps are not permitted.

Junior riders under 17 Yrs are to wear jodhpurs boots only in all rider, pony hack and junior hack classes. Any person who, in the opinion of the Marshalling Steward is not suitably attired with correct saddlery for the class shall be excluded from entering the main arena or competing in an event.

**ALL PERSONS entering the ring must be wearing enclosed footwear.**

**PLEASE NOTE: AN APPROVED SAFETY HELMET WILL BE MANDATORY FOR ALL YOUTH RIDERS.**

### **HORSE/PONY REGISTRATION PAPERS**

Registration papers must be available for inspection on request by Stewards - **NO EXCEPTIONS.** Checks will be carried out and if you do not have your registration papers to show the Judge/Ring Steward then you will not be allowed to enter the class. Also note that if at any time after the class you are asked to show your registration papers and you fail to do so then no prize money will be awarded.

**No Papers – No Entry**

### **IN AWARDING CHAMPIONSHIPS**

The Judges will be required to select the next animal or rider in order of merit, to be called 'Reserve' which may, if the Judges consent, take the place of the Champion in the event of the Champion being disqualified for any reason.

## **PERSONS EXHIBITING A REGISTERED HORSE/PONY**

Persons exhibiting a registered horse/pony as an unregistered exhibit or vice versa will be disqualified. Persons knowingly entering an exhibit in a class for which it is not eligible will be disqualified.

## **UNREGISTERED HORSE/PONY**

To clarify this rule, this means THAT NO horse/pony that has been registered with a Breed or Colour Society at any time during its life may enter this class.

## **STALLIONS**

May only compete in classes that state they are eligible. Stallions may not be ridden, driven, or handled by persons under 18 years of age and must wear a bit and chain for all LED classes. Stallions are to be secured at all times, any unwanted or disruptive behaviour may result in a request to leave the premises. Stallions/colts will have first preference to stables. Please advise on your nomination form if you are bringing a colt/stallion. All stallions MUST be stabled in stallion stalls. No stallion is to be moved around a venue without a suitable restraint. The restraint can be a bridle, a rearing bit or a chain lead rein over the nose or under the jaw. It is the stallion owners/rider's responsibility to ensure that all possible safety precautions are taken. Stallions must not be left unattended.

## **PARADED EXHIBITS**

All exhibits paraded in any section must be under complete control, stewards reserve the right to request the handler/rider of any animal to leave the ring to ensure the safety of other exhibits, competitors, handlers.

## **UNDER DISQUALIFY ACTION**

**NO PERSON, HORSE, PONY** under disqualify action recognised by the Society may exhibit or compete.

## **CONDUCT UNBECOMING**

Any Person/s either on site or via social media who are deemed by the Committee to have placed the TPA&M Ass Inc into disrepute will be removed from the grounds and asked to remove all social media posts pertaining to said offence. This includes violence, threats or bullying to any and all parties (competitors, volunteers, judges, stewards, committee members or members of the public). **No exceptions.**

## **FORMAL OBJECTION**

Only the owner, or his authorised agent, or the rider of a horse taking part in the competition is entitled to lodge an objection. Objections must be made in writing to the Secretary of the event accompanied by a deposit of \$50:

- Not later than half an hour after the happening which gave rise to the objection or,
- Where marks are concerned, within half an hour of the issue of the marks, or, in the case of objections to the qualifications of competitors, not later than half an hour before the start of the event, or,
- In the case of objections to the Showjumping course, not later than 10 minutes after the walking of the course and before the start of the competition.

**If the objection is upheld you will receive your \$50 deposit back, if dismissed the \$50 deposit will be forfeited.**

## HACK CLASSIFICATION

**PONY HACKS:** Not to exceed 12hh and to be ridden by a boy or girl 14 years & under.

**RIDING PONIES & SADDLE PONIES:** Not to exceed 14hh to 14.2hh but over 14hh cannot enter the Pony Ring to compete, must compete in Galloway Ring

**GALLOWAY HACKS:** Over 14hh not exceeding 15hh. May be ridden by persons of any age.

**LADIES GALLOWAY HACKS:** Must be ridden by a female of any age.

**HACKS:** Over 15hh. May be ridden by persons of any age.

**LADIES HACKS:** Must be ridden by a female 17 years & over.

**MAIDEN HACKS:** Horse/Galloway/Pony means they have not won a first placing at any Agricultural Show in a similar competition.

**NOVICE HACKS:** Horse/Galloway/Pony means they have not won an open class or Championship at any Agricultural Show.

**PLEASURE HACKS:** Classes must be ridden in a plain snaffle, no spurs, whips or dropped nose band.

**LOCAL HACKS:** Horse/Galloway/Pony/Rider means permanent resident & owned within the Charters Towers Regional Council area for a period of six months prior to the show.

**DISTRICT HACKS:** Horses/Galloways/Ponies/Riders means they have resided in the district for six months or more preceding the forthcoming show radius of Charters Towers. Refer to District Map.

**HUNTER HACKS:** Competitors please note – Horses shown as Hacks may not compete as Hunter Hacks.

- Horses are not to be wearing Ear Bonnets or Boots
- No change of saddle is allowed between sections
- Whips to be a maximum length of 75cm
- Stallions are not eligible

## HOUSEHOLD ANIMALS IN RING

Please be advised that under NO circumstances are DOGS or other household pets allowed to enter the equestrian ring.

## **SHOWJUMPING RULES**

### **JUMPING COMPETITORS PLEASE NOTE:**

- All events will be guided by current **EA GUIDELINES** unless otherwise stated.
- **PCAQ** members are required to present their current membership number when entering or they are not allowed to compete in PCAQ jumping events.
- All horses must be base registered with Equestrian Australia. Riders also must be members of Equestrian Australia. Horses can have 3 starts per day (E.A. & T.P.A & M.A. Rule) One horse one rider per day
- All events will be jumped out to decide the final places. If by any circumstance an event cannot be completed, the committee reserves the right to decide what, if any, prize money will be awarded.
- **Parents, grooms or coaches may not enter the ring unless they are acting as practice jump helpers, however they **MUST** leave the ring immediately when the competitor enters the competition ring.**
- **LOCAL EVENTS** are to be locally owned and ridden. (Local being defined as within the Charters Towers Regional Council Boundaries, must have permanently resided in the area for six months prior to the show).
- **DISTRICT EVENTS** embrace all the territory north from Mackay and west taking in the towns of Charters Towers, Hughenden, Richmond then north to Cape York as per map.
- **ENTRY TICKETS** are needed to be able to compete in the event.

## **NO ENTRY TICKET – NO START**

- **Horses may only compete in THREE height classes per day**
- Excessive whipping/spurring/rein pulling will not be tolerated and offenders will be disqualified from the event and all future jumping events at this show. **NO BLOOD POLICY.**
- Horses competing in junior event(s) cannot compete also in same open feature events (6 Bars).
- The committee reserves the right to change events to suit nominations received.
- Competitors please note **there will be no HC show jumping.**

## **OPEN SHOWJUMPING**

- Open to all competitors except classes **1, 2, & 3 (PCAQ ONLY)**
- Open jumping classes are open to **all ages** of riders however;
- Horse can only start in **3 jumping events per day – One horse, one rider per day**
- Junior riders are eligible to ride open on the same horse/s that they competed on in Junior or PCAQ events.

## **SHOWJUMPING HORSES ARE ONLY ALLOWED 3 STARTS PER DAY – ONE HORE ONE RIDER PER DAY**

**NOTE: Micro Chip Scanning will be done to prove the identity of your retired racehorse/s prior to the OFF THE TRACK GRAND PRIX.**

## **DRESSAGE RULES**

Nominations close Friday 25<sup>th</sup> July 2025 at 4pm.

**Please Note: NO LATE NOMINATIONS will be accepted.**

- Refer to General Conditions of Entry & Competition in front of schedule.
- The Dressage Events are guided by EA (Formally Equestrian Federation of Australia) rules.
- Name of rider and horse must be stated at the time of entry.
- Entry fees must be paid in full or nomination will not be accepted.
- Please send nomination forms together with appropriate entry fees to: Charters Towers Show, PO Box 141, Charters Towers QLD 4820
- Please use 1 entry form per rider. If no payment or evidence of payment of entry fees are provided, then nomination will not be accepted.
- Draw will be available for viewing at the Office Saturday evening from 4pm.
- Please contact Show Office if you require more information. Details on front cover.
- Neither the Organising Committee of any competition to which these rules apply accepts any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, grounds, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever.
- Helmets are compulsory – use of helmets that conform to Australian Standard.
- All competitors are required to complete a gear check immediately prior to riding each test.
- The committee reserves the right to alter, amend or cancel any event on the program without notice.
- It is the responsibility of the competitor to ensure the nominations are made correctly at the time of entry close date.
- Dress code – sleeved shirts and tie, stock or ratcatcher. Jackets are optional.
- **Stockhorse Dressage** can ride in either stock/western saddles and the dress code is Western attire. May enter both Green Horse classes if have appropriate saddles.
- The committee reserves the right to change events to suit nominations received.

## **ENTRIES**



- One rider per horse.
- Junior riders (6yrs to 16yrs) age as at 1<sup>st</sup> January 2025.
- Senior riders (17yrs & over) age as at 1<sup>st</sup> January 2025.

## HACK RULES

### Important Information

- A Maiden is one which has not won 1<sup>st</sup> Prize at any Agricultural Show Class.
- A Novice has never won an open Championship at an Agricultural Show Class.
- All Ponies may be measured at the discretion of the committee. All Ponies to be ridden by a girl or boy 14 Yrs and under unless otherwise stated.

## HUNTER RULES

- Headgear to be worn in accordance with EA Regulations and must have the appropriate chin strap.
- All Classes to be ridden in an English Style Saddle.
- Bridles are to have plain brow bands and no coloured ribbons are to be worn in hair.
- Junior Riders are not permitted to wear top boots (Junior Rider 16 Yrs & under).

## WORKING STOCKHORSE CHALLENGE RULES

### Important Information

- Type, Presentation and Overall Impression will be judged before the working pattern.
- Some working patterns may require a whip.
- Open to all breeds
- Stallions, Mares and Geldings are all eligible
- Either western or stock saddles allowed.

### General Presentation

#### Presentation of horse as follows:

- The horse should be clean.
- Protective leg gear permitted.

#### Presentation of tack as follows:

- Ensure that the tack is neat and tidy.
- Ensure that the tack is correctly fitted and does not rub or disturb the horse.
- A riding whip is not permitted.

#### Presentation of handler or rider as follows:

- The handler or rider's attire should be neat.
- The handler/rider should have neat and tidy hair.

### Rider Classes

To demonstrate the all-round horse showing ability and manners at all paces and the ability of riders to control and work their mount at all paces, riders may be asked to extend at all paces.

### Working Horse Classes

These are patterned classes showing the horse and riders skills they need to work cattle.

## RANCH RULES

### Competitor Information

Patterns will be handed out on the morning of the competition. **All Ranch Classes to be judged under the HSAA and AQHA rulebooks.**

**For Open classes, Senior Horses (aged 6 years and over) must be ridden in curb bit with chain and Junior Horses (aged 5 years and under) can be ridden in snaffle bit, hackamore or curb bit. Full western attire as per rulebook.**

### Ranch Pleasure:

A superior ranch riding horse has a free-flowing stride of reasonable length in keeping with his conformation and covering a reasonable amount of ground as if he were going across the pasture to do a task on the ranch in a timely fashion. Horse should not be a runaway, but 'we' have a lot to do today. Ideally, he should have a balanced, flowing motion, while exhibiting correct gaits with proper cadence and rhythm. The quality of the movement and consistency of the gaits is a major consideration. This class is judged on the rail – like a pleasure class.

### Ranch Riding (Pattern Class):

The purpose of this class is to bring forth the versatility in both the ranch horse and exhibitor. In the task of performing 1 of the 4 designated patterns, each horse will work individually performing one of the required four (4) patterns offered in the rulebook that is chosen by the judge. Horses will be scored on a basis of 0-100, with 70 denoting an average performance. Simple or flying lead changes allowed.

### Ranch Trail (Pattern Class):

This class will be judged on the performance of the horse over obstacles with emphasis on manners, response to the rider and quality of movement. Credit will be given to horses negotiating the obstacles with style and some degree of speed, providing correctness is not sacrificed. Horses should receive credit for showing attentiveness to the obstacles and the capability of picking their own way through the course when obstacles warrant it, and willingly responding to the rider's cues on more difficult obstacles.

### Ranch Attire

Western Shirt (long sleeved), Western Hat (or helmet), Jeans, Belt, Boots, Chaps (optional), Western Saddle, Western Bridle, Spurs (optional – please check individual classes). No hoof polish, mane and tail not to be braided or banded, no Bling Shirts.

**Note:** *In the Walk Jog and Beginner Green Horse Rider Classes any type of saddle is allowed (English Stock Saddle or Western). Riders Attire – Long Sleeved Shirt, Hat, Pants and Riding Boots.*

## TINY TOT RULES

### Important Information

- Children must be 2-6 Yrs. The following classes are for LED line children only.
- Children must be wearing a helmet and be on a lead rope.
- Parents have full responsibility for their child's welfare.
- Anything deemed unsafe will be removed from the ring.

## QUARTPOT CHALLENGE RULES

- This event has been organised to introduce young riders to the concepts of both futurities and stock horse challenges, in the space and time available at this show.
- Riders may have no more than two horses. Children may be mounted on Ponies, Galloways or Horses.

*Judges will be looking for the most suitable mount for a child to take mustering for a day. Age, size and compatibility with mount will be taken into consideration.*

### **Round 1 – LED**

(Score – 50% conformation, 30% presentation, 20% showmanship)

Applies to all Pintpot, Quartpot and Campfire Riders.

### **Round 2 – Under Saddle**

(Score – Paces and correct workout 50%, manners 20%, overall presentation of horse and rider 30%)

Pintpot – Must be able to walk, trot and canter in both directions, change lead, halt. In the Time Trial must be able to open gate but do not need to close it.

Quartpot – Riders may be asked to walk, trot, canter in both directions, change lead and lengthen canter, halt and rein back, walk back on a loose rein.

Campfire – Same as Quartpot as well as jump, obstacles, carry object, get on/off horse.

Judges are looking for a calm, supple and obedient horse that moves freely forward in all paces.

### **Round 3 – Time Trial**

(This is a timed event. It is a test of the horses' ability and tractability. The course reflects many of the obstacles that may be encountered in the bush; it may include small obstacles to jump).

Pintpots will have a smaller course.

### **Off The Track Thoroughbreds**

Horses do not need to be plaited. This is to show the versatility of the OTT racehorse. Will be run the same as the Quartpots. Will be required to complete all the same challenges as the Quartpots. Micro Chip Scanning may be done to prove the identity of your retired racehorse/s.

*Winner is total of all 3 rounds.*
