

Led Cattle Section Conditions of Entry

- 1. This will be a Covid Safe Event- please stay home, if you are feeling unwell, have any Covid symptoms, or been in contact with any confirmed Covid cases.
- 2. All Cattle must be weighed 7 days immediately before the commencement of the competition. Please complete the weight declaration form. Stewards reserve the right to re-weigh cattle at their discretion.
- 3. All bulls 6 months and over must have a nose ring and be led by the nose ring and halter. Bulls under 6 months must have a nose ring or clip. All other cattle must have nose ring or clip.
- 4. All handlers must be capable of handling and controlling any animal in their care. TPAMA Inc. holds each exhibitor responsible to maintain a safe place and system of work during their occupation of any area of the Showgrounds. Any unsafe work practices must be reported to the Co-ordinators or TPAMA officials.
- 5. The coordinators, Judge and/or Stewards reserve the right to reject any entries not considered suitable for the competition. In the case of insufficient numbers being nominated in any class or breed the committee retains the right to suspend or combine classes at its discretion at any time.
- 6. TPAMA Inc reserves the right to substitute vouchers / products for money for prizes.
- 7. All exhibitors must have current & paid-up public liability insurance and it must cover travelling to Shows.
- To accommodate unforeseen circumstances, the TPAMA committee will refund nomination money if the exhibitor advises of their inability to attend if notification is given to the TPAMA office by phone, or email prior to 5pm Friday 19th July 2024.
- 9. The TPAMA Inc will not be responsible for any accidents, damage, death, loss, alteration or omission that may be caused through, or by, an exhibit or exhibitor, and it shall be a condition of entry that such exhibitor will hold the Association blameless and indemnified against legal proceedings arising out of such accident, damage, death, loss, alteration or omission. If you are unsure about the effect of this clause, please seek your own legal advice at your own cost prior to entering the event.
- 10. The Judge's decision is final and no discussion will be entered into with the Judge about their decision or its merits.
- 11. The TPAMA Inc make a commitment that, if three or more individual vendors in any breed group are represented, we will run that section individually. Outside of our standard Bos Indicus and Bos Taurus grouping.
- 12. Proof of registration of Stud Cattle to be in by Monday 22nd July 2024
- 13. To compete in an age class competition, you must be that age on that day.

Conditions,

- 1. Nominations close Sunday 7th July 2024
- 2. Entries should show, Section, Class and animal identification.
- 3. Entry fees \$20 per animal Led, \$25 per class for Stabled Competition.
- 4. All nomination forms, and NVD to be emailed to mail@ctshow.com.au
- 5. All exhibits in stud classes must be accompanied by a certificate from a breed society.
- 6. All cattle to be of show standard and must be free of Ticks and injuries.
- 7. Ages of stud cattle will be calculated from July 1st.
- 8. Ribbons will be rewarded to First, Second and Third places.
- 9. Any calf shown on a cow is not eligible to be shown in any other classes.
- 10. ALL animals over 6 months of age must have a nose ring or clip attached when handled on grounds.
- 11. GRAND PARADE, all prize winners must parade, penalties could include prize money, trophies and ribbons being forfeited.

13. Grand Champion Exhibitor & Champion Sires Progeny Group, a scoring system will be applied to each class, (See table above). Points accumulated across competitions and will be aggregated to identify the most successful Stud section exhibitor of the competition. Sires Progeny Group will be awarded to most points accumulated by progeny of an individual sire (Both genders must be represented). You do not need to enter this class on your nomination form, all exhibitors are automatically eligible.

Commercial Cattle Competition, Chief Cattle Steward: Karl Knuth

Terms and conditions of the 2025 Commercial Cattle Competition

1. All exhibits to be on the grounds by 5:00pm Monday 28th July

2. Entry Fee of \$20 per class, maximum \$120 per exhibitor across all competitions.

3. Wild, Dangerous or Unwell cattle may be disqualified at the discretion of the Chief cattle steward.

4. Cattle to be polled or dehorned. Recently branded, dehorned or castrated cattle which could be subject to bleeding will be disqualified.

5. All cattle must belong to and be bred by the exhibitor.

6. All cattle in classes which require mouthing and weighing must be mouthed and weighed prior to arrival at the grounds and may be mouthed and/or weighed by stewards at their discretion on arrival. Cattle are to be "wet"/ "Full" and 6% less will be subtracted from their full weight recorded on supplementary sheet. After submitting a nomination form, exhibitors will be supplied with a supplementary sheet and must be completed in full by the exhibitor for each class and submitted to the show office via email at mail@ctshow.com.au by 5:00pm Sunday 27th July.

7. The most successful exhibitor will be calculated on the following basis: First place, 3 points; second place, 2 points; third place.

8.Any dispute that may arise must be reported to a member of the Show Committee and shall be settled by no less than One representative of the Cattle Committee, One representative of the broader Show committee and the Chief Cattle Steward. Their collaborative decision is final.

9. Only the chief Steward and Cattle Judge have the right to alter and transfer any entry to a more suitable class.

10. All entries to be visually free of cattle ticks and exhibited under Biosecurity Queensland Regulations with accompanying NATIONAL VENDER DECLARATION FORMS and be identified with an NLIS device.

11. All fees and costs associated with the Transport, Housing and feeding of livestock at the H.M. Clarke Saleyards or Charters Towers Show Grounds will be the sole responsibility of the exhibitor. Please refer to the Charters Towers Regional Council 2022/2023 Schedule of fees and charges for more information. www.charterstowers.qld.gov.au/fees-and-charges

12. The Committee undertakes to care for all cattle exhibited but will not be held responsible for any loss whatsoever.

13. The exhibitor has the sole responsibility for supplying their animals with feed and water and all appropriate containers that are required to do so.

FYI: There is no plan to hold an Auction on site at the Charters Towers Show Grounds.

2025 Commercial Cattle Classes (At Showgrounds)

Class 75. PEN OF 5 X WEANERS.

Open to all breeds, each pen is to be a line of either 5 x heifers OR 5 x steers - not mixed.

Must be under 12 months of age and weaned recently. Judged on temperament, evenness of line, conformation and weight for age.

Class 76. Pen of <u>3</u> Retainer heifers.

Judged on evenness of line, conformation, weight for age and temperament.

SPEC: Milk Tooth, 12 – 24 Months

MOST SUCCESSFUL PENNED EXHIBITOR

A scoring system will be applied to each class as follows – first place, 3 points; second place, 2 points; third place, 1 point. Points accumulated inside breed groups and will be aggregated to identify the most successful exhibitor of the competition. You do not need to "enter" this class on your Nomination Form, all exhibitors are automatically eligible.

CLASS 1. PEN OF 10 X PRIME BULLOCKS Open to all breeds. Judged on temperament, evenness of line, fat cover, conformation and weight for age. 0-8 TOOTH

CLASS 2. PEN OF 10 X PRIME COWS Open to all breeds. Judged on temperament, evenness of line, fat cover, conformation and weight for age. 0-8 TOOTH

CLASS 3. PEN OF 10 X TRADE STEERS Open to all breeds. Judged on temperament, evenness of line, fat cover, conformation and weight for age. 0-4 TOOTH, 400-520KG.

CLASS 4. PEN OF 10 X TRADE HEIFERS Open to all breeds. Judged on temperament, evenness of line, fat cover, conformation and weight for age. 0-4 TOOTH 400-520KG

CLASS 5. SINGLE BEST BULLOCK Open to all breeds.

Judged on temperament, evenness of line, fat cover, conformation and weight for age. 0-8 TOOTH.

CLASS 6. SINGLE BEST COW Open to all breeds.

Judged on temperament, evenness of line, fat cover, conformation and weight for age. 0-8 TOOTH.

ANY INDIVIDUAL ANIMAL FROM CLASSES 1 – 6 ARE ELIGIBLE FOR THE <u>PIP KNUTH MEMORIAL TROPHY – CHAMPION PRIME EXHIBIT</u>
